



Current status of the digital divide in the elderly

- As the digitalization of society as a whole progresses, it is an important policy issue to eliminate the "digital gap" between those who can master digital technology and those who do not.
- In particular, smartphones are tools that allow individuals to easily perform online procedures, and there is an urgent need to provide sufficient support to those who need them.

Overview of Digital Utilization Support Promotion Project

Due to the new coronavirus infection, there is a need to expand the use of online services that "avoid contact with people." However, many elderly people are worried about the use of digital technology, and online administrative procedures are not being used for reasons such as "I do not know that electronic applications can be made". It was For this reason, in collaboration with private companies and local public organizations, "classes" on how to use smartphones such as online administrative procedures at mobile shops nationwide to alleviate anxiety about digital utilization by the elderly, etc. To carry out.

Demonstration at 11 locations nationwide in the 2nd year of Reiwa, and implemented as a subsidy project after the 3rd year of Reiwa.

In order to eliminate the digital divide, we provide advice and consultation on administrative procedures and how to use private services with high usage needs in places close to the elderly.

Implementation policy of Reiwa 4th year project

From the 3rd year of Reiwa (2 0 2 1), mobile phone shops nationwide will hold "classes" to support explanations and consultations on how to use smartphones, such as online administrative procedures, in order to eliminate elderly people who are worried about digital utilization. implementation (Example of class: How to apply for My Number Card / How to use MynaPortal, e-Tax, online medical care / Basic operation of smartphone / How to use the Internet, etc.) Assuming implementation in 5 years from Reiwa 3 to 7, we plan to dispatch instructors in consideration of cities, towns and villages (750 cities, towns and villages (*)) that do not have mobile shops after 4 years (* November 10, Reiwa 3). totaling)

We train instructors for digital utilization support promotion projects with advanced skills that will be the leaders of the region, and dispatch instructors to cities, towns and villages where there are no mobile shops to provide support.




